


Where Is Usage Today?

First Consumer Reports on Iwaspoisoned.com

On August 21, 2015, three reports citing a total of 11 people experiencing illness after consuming food at a Chipotle restaurant in Simi Valley, California.

Me and my friend both ate chipotle together and got really sick the next day

Ordered 2 burrito bowls, 1 veggie, 1 chicken. 2 customers all the same symptoms at the same time

Got very sick, hospitalized
6 Friends confirmed sick as well.
Same meal.



Chipotle voluntarily closed on the afternoon of Friday 21st and posted a sign on the door citing:

Monday August 24th



Ventura County Conducts Inspection

- Violations were for failures in pest control, sanitation, and maintenance.
- Employees were working without valid food handler cards as required by California law.
- Restrooms were both unclean and not in good repair.
- The toilet base inside the front stall of the women's lavatory was not secured to the floor.
- Tiles were missing, there were gaps in and around a self-serve soda fountain,
- Mildew on the deflector panel inside the ice machine and on the back splash wall of the washing sink.
- There was also grease and food debris in the lower compartment of the deep fryer.

Officials investigate illness outbreak at Ventura County Chipotle

By VERONICA ROCHA AUG 25, 2015 | 10:50 PM

"Officials say dozens of customers fell ill after eating at a Chipotle in Simi Valley.

Ventura County health officials believe at least 60 patrons felt sick after eating at the Mexican food restaurant Aug. 18 and Aug. 19.

Now the Ventura County Public Health Department is conducting an investigation to determine what caused the outbreak, which forced the restaurant to close its doors for a day."

In the meantime...

August 27th

A follow-up inspection, and Chipotle had corrected six of the seven violations it received in the first inspection. It was ordered to immediately discontinue holding potentially hazardous foods at unapproved temperatures

From the inspection report: "A container of cooked beef was observed holding at 118 F at the steam table at the front service counter, The operator voluntarily disposed of the food item."

At the second inspection, the Chipotle manager said that a "more stringent" hand-washing policy was being imposed.

Friday September 4th



Two weeks after First Reports

Ventura County Department of Health, California, confirmed a Norovirus outbreak linked to Chipotle.


Report Count vs County Population - Michigan








